The expansive 1,800 acre development is bordered on the east by the Gulf of Mexico and on the west by Corpus Christi Bay.

Experience the beauty and challenge of the Scottish links-style design. The golf course is surrounded by vibrant coastal foliage and embraced by an exhilarating ocean breeze. Combining scenic views of the Gulf of Mexico, rolling fairways, native dunes, abundant wildlife and a commitment to world-class customer service, Newport Dunes is sure to leave a lasting impression on all who play it. Newport Dunes Golf Club opened to the public in September of 2008 and is already being compared to the best links golf courses in the country. Inspired by the great courses in Scotland and Ireland (where the game was born), Newport Dunes represents the first ocean-side design by Mr. Arnold Palmer in North America.
